WELCOME TO THE MARCH NEWS BULLETIN FROM BRIXTON PARISH COUNCIL

Welcome to the March bulletin from Brixton Parish Council (BPC).

The Parish Council meets monthly in either the Brixton Community Room (adjacent to St Mary's school) or Sherford Community Hub, with the June meeting being held in Carrollsland. The meeting location will be rotated and advertised prior to the meeting. Councillors welcome the opportunity to meet parishioners in the other areas of the parish.

The location of our meetings is constantly reviewed as we are mindful of the safety of parishioners and councillors alike. All working group meetings are continuing via zoom.

Brixton Parish Council has a Business Continuity Plan. This can be viewed on www.brixonparishcouncil.org.uk along with the councils' other policies.

Traffic Calming Red Lion Hill / Stamps Hill

BPC is in discussion with DCC officials regarding plans for traffic calming measures along Red Lion Hill and Stamps Hill. s106 funding from the Sherford development is available for this project. DCC is currently working on proposals which will then be subject to a public consultation led by BPC.

Monkey Lane

DCC have issued a request for a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) for Monkey Lane to be downgraded to a multi-use lane (Pedestrians, Cyclists and Horse Riders) with a prohibition of vehicles except for access. This will be referred to Highways and Traffic Orders Committee and timescales are approx. 6 months for the scheme to be implemented.

Highways

BPC Traffic Management Working Group continues to meet remotely with DCC Highways Officer on a quarterly basis and the next meeting will be held in April. If you would like to attend or have any highways related issues or any questions for a future meeting please email

A new VAS solar powered sign has been purchased and will be placed along A379. This will be moved on a regular basis to encourage drivers to abide by the speed limits.

River Yealm Water Quality Group

This working group with the 7 Riparian Parish Councils in the River Yealm Catchment area together with other interested parties continues to meet to work with Environment Agency and South West Water to look at improving the quality of water in the River Yealm particularly relating to the discharge of sewage into the river at times of heavy rainfall. regularly used. The warm hub in The
Foxhound is extremely popular on
Thursday afternoons and will continue as
a regular community event to help

Land at Cofflete Creek

BPC owns the parcel of land at the head of Cofflete Creek on the site of the former Cofflete Mill. The aim is to create a community amenity space for the residents of Brixton Parish, through careful consideration of the significant historic and environmental value of this piece of land. BPC is now looking at creating a project plan for the higher section.

Brixton Parish Environment Working Group
