

## **Steer Point Quarry Restoration report from Nick Leaney for November 2022**

Here is the update on the Steer Point Restoration for your 30 November meeting for the period of 1 October 2022 to 31 October 2022.

- The total number of HGV deliveries for the reporting period was 272 into the site which represented 98% of the permitted number over that period
- The weekly average was 68 loads with the maximum number of permitted loads in any one week of 70 into the site was achieved only once in this reporting period

To date the site has imported 107,000m<sup>3</sup> of the permitted 140,000m<sup>3</sup> under the current planning permission.

We continue to have the same complainant reporting dust, speed and noise issues associated with lorries leaving site described as 'going at crazy speed and creating a deafening noise'. We continue to remind the site operator and hauliers of their duty of care in this regard especially during this wet period of weather. We have had no other complaints from residents on Steer Point Road or walkers/cyclists/rides using the road or indeed from the village.
