John,

As discussed I have arranged for traffic surveys to be undertaken before, during and after the Sherford Road closure.

The "before" survey was undertaken on Wednesday 25th April, and the "during" on Wednesday 23rd May 2018. The "after" is being undertaken tomorrow (Weds 27th June).

I have attached a plan which shows the results of the 12 hour surveys of the "before" and "during" periods.

In summary this shows:-

- Two-way traffic flows on Sherford Road were around 4,000 vehicles per day before the road closure.
- Before the closure there were around 2,000 vehicles per day using the road to Brixton (Stamps Hill) south of Sherford Cross.
- After the closure, there were an extra 2,000 vehicles per day using the Brixton road (ie the flow on this road has doubled)
- This suggests that the other 2,000 vehicles that were using Sherford Road, are currently using alternative routes whilst the closure is in place.

I will provide a further update once tomorrows survey results are available, probably in mid July.
